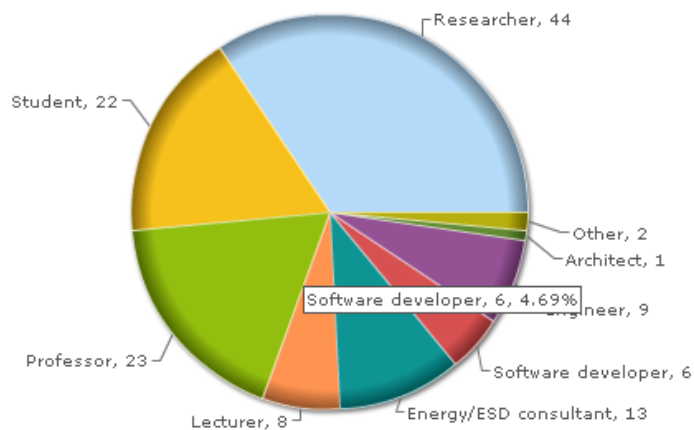

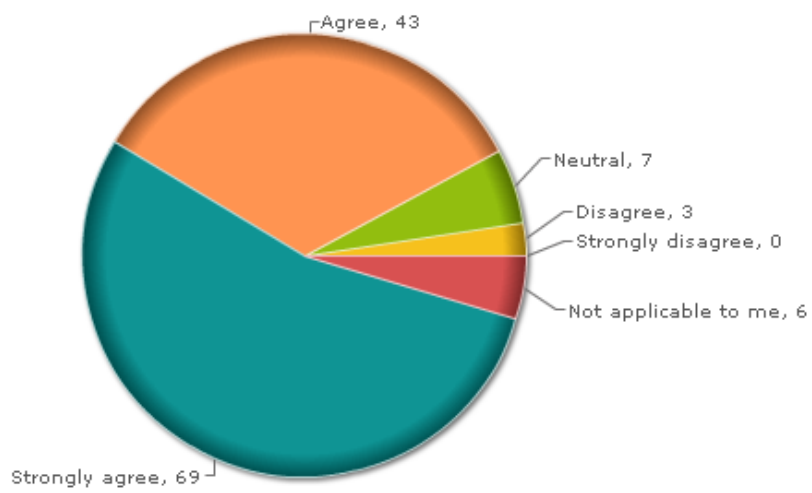

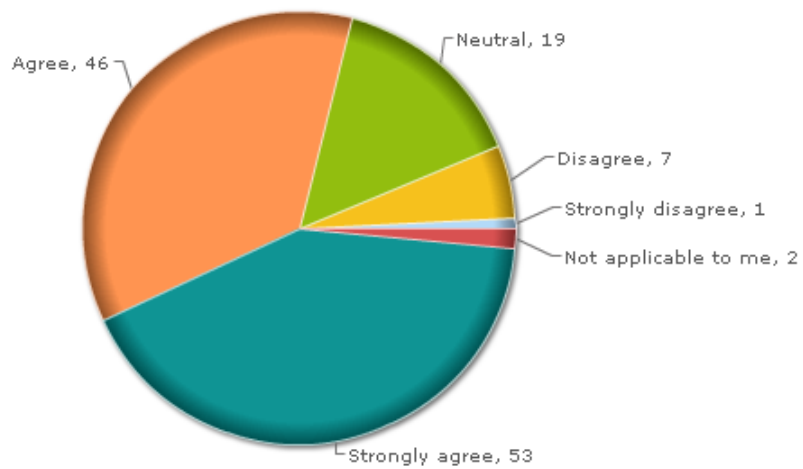
There was enough relevant content on Day 2



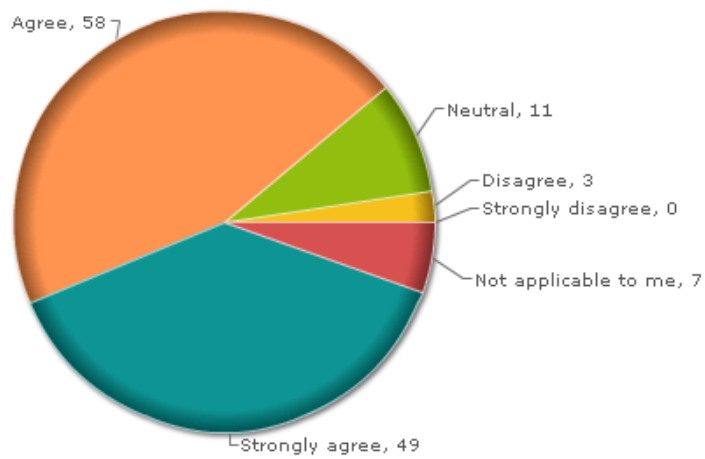

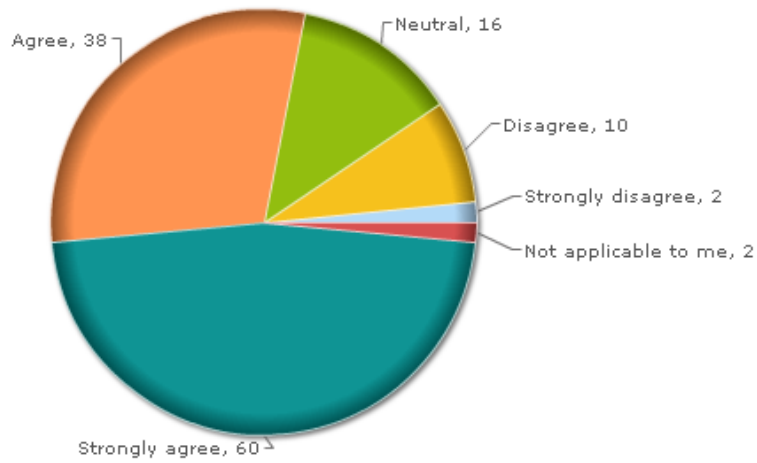
The conference program was clearly presented and easy to follow



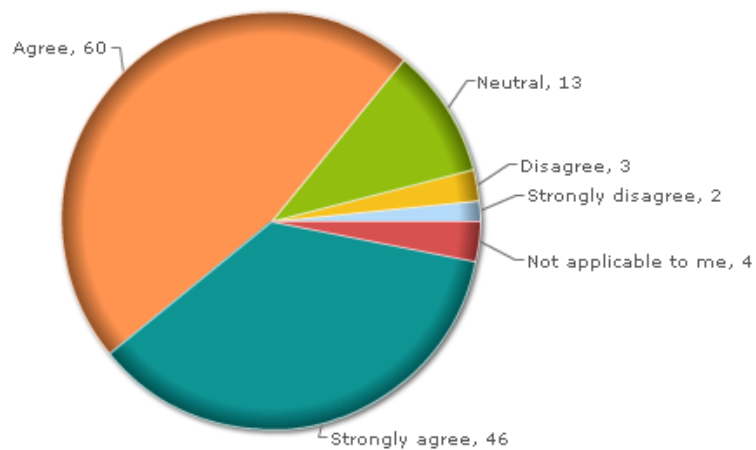

The venue and catering were suitable for the conference

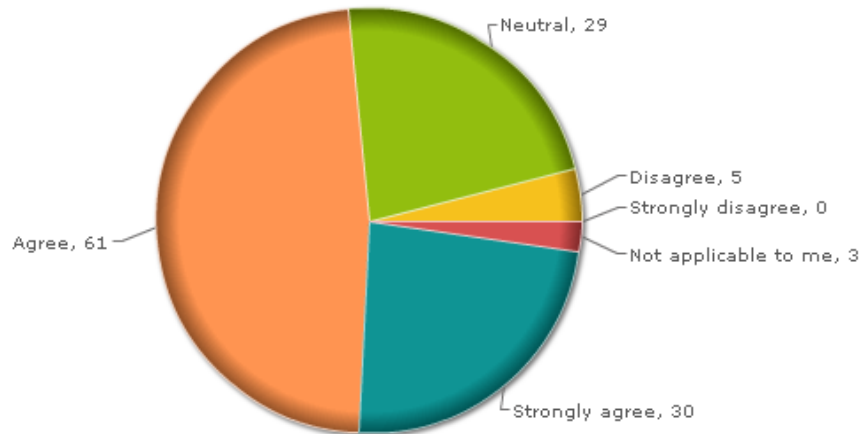
